Shall Lawson Reorganized School District No. R-XIV of Ray County, Missouri, issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$3,000,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, repairing, improving, extending, remodeling, renovating, furnishing, and equipping new and existing school facilities, including but not limited to the following:

- Constructing an Agriculture Education Learning Lab space, including an agriculture mechanics shop and classroom
- Parking lot pavement repair and overlay

If this proposition is approved, the District's debt service tax levy is estimated to remain unchanged at the current debt service tax levy of \$1.0051 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
